Overview	This Regulated Qualification has been developed to provide the knowledge and skills to manage patients with allergic reactions, anaphylaxis and other conditions that lead to them becoming unconscious, not breathing, or result in cardiac arrest. Anaphylaxis is a potentially life-threatening condition and prompt action in its recognition and management is essential to preserve life. This course provides the underpinning knowledge and appropriate skills to manage patients and ultimately if required to perform effective basic life support until emergency assistance can arrive.
